HILTONS On Saturday, October 30, 2021, at 7:30 p.m. the Carter Family Fold in Hiltons, Virginia, will present a concert of bluegrass music by Sunrise Ridge. Admission to the concert is \$10 for adults, \$2 for children 6 to 11, under age 6 free. Doors open at 6 p.m. The Carter Museum and Carter birthplace cabin are open from 6 p.m. until 7:30 p.m. and again at intermission.

The Sunrise Ridge bluegrass band is from Whitesburg, Kentucky. For the past nine years, Sunrise Ridge has performed at festivals, square dances at venues like the Stringbean Memorial Festival, the Osborne Brothers Hometown Festival, and Cole's Bluegrass Barn. Shows feature hard driving, toe-tapping fiddle and banjo favorites and some gospel tunes with great harmony.

Sunrise Ridge features Shawn Stamper on guitar and lead vocals, Jack Adams on banjo. The guys are backed up by three ladies on guitar, bass, and fiddle. This will be the group's fourth performance at the
